

## NOTES ON THE CLOTHES LIST

1. This list names those articles that are authorized for wear at School. The limitations set down here must be observed. The numbers stated are the MINIMUM required.
2. All clothing must be CLEAN and IN GOOD REPAIR at the beginning of each term.
3. ALL ARTICLES MUST BE MARKED WITH NAME TAPES.  
Games kit must be named on the outside (on the left side at the front); this applies to rugby jerseys, cricket shirts, white sweater, all shorts and tracksuit.
4. Sixth-formers may wear any smart, dark-coloured overcoat with plain buttons. Army great-coats, combat jackets, etc., are NOT allowed.
5. Shoes other than suede must be capable of being polished to a shine (i.e. not 'greasy' leather). Raised heels and very thick soles are not allowed.
